

Which is the goal of RedLACC?




The goal of RedLACC is the promotion of cooperation in basic research of behavior, mainly in Latin America.



Which is the origin of RedLACC?



RedLACC was born in the XVII Biennial Meeting of the International Society for Comparative Psychology (ISCP) in Bogota, Colombia, September 2014.



Who is now in RedLACC?



A growing number (+100) researchers and advanced students of disciplines as: comparative psychology, experimental analysis of behavior, ethology, behavioral neuroscience, behavioral economics, evolutionary psychology, veterinary medicine, between others. From the next countries: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Peru, Colombia, Costa Rica, Mexico, U. S. A. and Spain.
